







Learning Journey - Our work, and how to support your child

This is the programme of learning for your child during their 6 weeks at Edison. There are many ways in which you can help your child whilst they are attending the centre, but the most effective way is to show an interest and to encourage your child to talk to you about what they are learning in school.

Our curriculum topics include:

- What makes me different?
- Small things
- What is the strongest bridge?
- Big things
- How can we make a car faster?
- Where does the sun go at night?

The teaching of these will be flexible and not all may be covered depending on the child's interests and needs.

English 	The children will be writing about the topics we are learning about. This might be through non fiction writing - reports, explanation text. There will also be the opportunity to use the outside area to develop their creative writing skills. We have a library which will be focused around our topics. Please encourage your child to read at home.
Mathematics 	In the Edison Centre we will be working on number fluency through playing maths games and other activities. We will be concentrating on learning number facts and times tables.
Art 	In art we will be experimenting with different drawing techniques to create different effects. All of our artwork will be linked to our topics. Other types of art will be created in theme or therapeutic sessions.
PE 	Each day children will be completing the daily mile. We will do this in the MUGA (covered playground). Please make sure that your child's PE kit is in school, and refer to the
Personal, Social and Emotional Education 	Your child will be working towards specific targets this term. We will encourage them to work as a team and improve their self esteem. They will also take part in therapeutic play sessions and outdoor learning to foster their emotional knowledge and awareness.
RE 	The children are learning about a variety of different faiths. They will talk about their beliefs and the beliefs of different religions.

Computing



The children will learn how to use the internet safely. They will use the internet to research learning topics. The children will also use educational apps to support their learning and general wellbeing, such as Duolingo and GoNoodle.
